Once upon a tale

This term we will be singing and reading about some of our favourite traditional tales such as The Gingerbread Man, The Three Little Pigs and Stickman. In our daily phonic sessions, we will continue learning Phase 2 sounds by adding new sounds and consolidating previously learned sounds through blending and segmenting. We will be investigating waterproof materials and baking Gingerbread men, as well as celebrating Bonfire Night, Remembrance, Diwali and Christmas. In Literacy, we will be drawing and labelling story maps to re-tell some of our favourite tales. In math's, we will begin to compare sets of objects and develop our vocabulary to describe amounts. Furthermore, we will explore the composition or 'parts' and 'wholes' of the numbers within 5, for example 4 is a whole number but 2 is a part and 2 is another part.

Outdoor Classroom. Outdoor Learning has always been a huge part of the Early Years curriculum and we are learning outdoors as much as possible at the moment. As well as our outdoor classroom and grass area, we will be taking walks into our Forest school in the woods. Please ensure your child has a coat with them every day and hats/ gloves as the weather starts to get colder **Please make sure all clothes, lunchboxes, bags and water bottles are labelled with your child's name.** It makes it so much easier to return them when they are lost!
