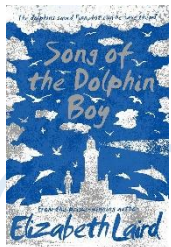
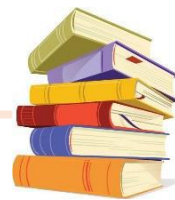


# Outstanding Oaks Newsletter Spring 2
