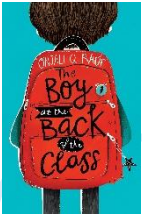
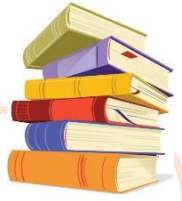


# Outstanding Oaks Newsletter Summer 2
