**Oliver's story:** At the age of 5 months old, Oliver was diagnosed with a high-grade Glioma (cancerous brain tumour) which had taken over the whole left side of his brain. He started treatment straight away and had countless surgeries, chemotherapy and other medical procedures. He was on treatment for 2.5 years and 2 years ago he was officially end of treatment and rang the bell. He has 2% of tumour left but that is stable. He does have mobility and speech problems due to the harsh treatment he was on but with the help from Glade Hill and other medical professionals we're hopeful that in the near future Oliver will get to where he needs to be.
